

Pool Rules

Please read the pool rules with your family and make sure all members of your family and guests understand and agree to follow these rules. These rules are meant to ensure a safe and fun swimming experience for everyone!

Failure to comply with these rules may result in revocation of pool access and assessment of fines if the actions of your or your guest(s) result in damage to or requires excessive cleaning of the pool and its facilities.

- 1) Horseplay, running, excessive splashing, rude or inappropriate language or any other activity that could be considered dangerous, disruptive or offensive to others is prohibited.
- 2) Absolutely **NO DIVING** anywhere in the pool.
- 3) There is no lifeguard on duty. Children under 14 <u>MUST</u> be accompanied and supervised by a responsible adult age 18 or older. **Babysitters must be 18 years of age or older**.
- 4) Diapers are prohibited in both pools. **Swim diapers are required.** Children 6 years & older are not allowed in the baby pool when babies are present.
- 5) If you or someone for which you are responsible has a bowel movement in the pool, you should first inform any swimmers currently in the pool and they should exit immediately. You should then make a good faith effort to remove the contaminant and finally, you should contact a Board member. The phone numbers to contact will be posted on the pool house. Remember, the longer the contaminant remains in the pool, the longer the pool must be closed in order to kill any bacteria present.
- 6) Keys should not be given or loaned to anyone. One key per household, replacement for lost cards will be \$15.
- 7) Make sure the gate closes behind you when you leave.
- 8) Two (2) guests per CP resident, 4 maximum per household.
- 9) Special events at the pool require prior written request and approval (see pool event request form on website).
- 10) No glass of any kind in the pool area. Please deposit cans, paper & other debris in the appropriate trash or recycling bins.
- 11) Pets are not allowed in the pool area.
- 12) No climbing or hanging on fence or gate.
- 13) Pool hours are 9 a.m. to 9 p.m.

**You, as a Crystal Park resident, are responsible for enforcing these rules & keeping our pool a family friendly place to relax. It is o.k. to let kids know when they break the rules, and if you find that you can not enforce the rules please get the offenders name & address and notify the board at crystal.park.hoa@gmail.com
